Such a release has qualified privilege in law which means a news provider may fulfil its duty in reproducing it.

If you are concerned that the information given to us was not accurate, you are free to raise this with East Sussex County Council.

If it notifies us that changes are required we will do so.

In May 2014 the European Court of Justice ruled that to protect privacy, individuals could request the removal of links from Google's European search results if the webpages concerned contained references to their name which were "irrelevant or excessive".

However, this so-called 'Right to Be Forgotten' ruling does not apply to news archives.

Individuals are, of course, welcome to approach Google with their complaint, however this does not read across into asking news providers such as ourselves to delete links from our archive.
