With reference to your communication dated 24/01/2026, please be advised that your status as a "digital distributor" provides no legal immunity under European Union and Italian Republic jurisdiction.

1. PUBLIC DISCLOSURE NOTICE (therecordspeaks.it) Please be formally notified that, for the purpose of transparency and public interest, **this entire communication and all subsequent correspondence between PressReader and the undersigned will be published on the portal therecordspeaks.it**. This platform serves as a forensic archive documenting institutional and corporate negligence. Your "standard procedures" and refusal to comply with GDPR will be made available for public and judicial scrutiny.

2. GDPR Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (Art. 3, par. 2, GDPR) As a Canadian/International entity distributing content within the EU/Italy, you are strictly subject to **Article 3(2) GDPR**. Your distribution of defamatory content and sensitive health data activates the authority of the Italian Public Prosecutor.

3. Formal Notice of Criminal Investigation (Procura della Repubblica) The **Public Prosecutor's Office in Pavia, Italy, has already initiated the formal investigative phase**. From this moment forward, **any further direct contact with the undersigned is strictly prohibited**. You are advised to consult a specialist in **Italian Criminal Law** immediately.

4. Forensic Evidence & Professional Standing This notice is issued by a certified **DPO and Forensic Expert (CCIAA)**. Your platform's delivery of the harmful content has been forensically logged.

Conclusion: Immediate global full removal removal (see previous email below) is required within **24 hours**. Your refusal will be documented on the public archive as evidence of *Dolo Omissivo* (Omitted Diligence).

Dear Editorial Team,

I am requesting an immediate editorial review of the
following article currently available on your platform:

The article contains inaccurate, outdated, and
procedurally inconsistent information. It reproduces
material originally circulated by East Sussex County
Council (ESCC), which has since been removed from its
official channels.

1. Inaccurate Timeline

Documentation from the Criminal Cases Review
Commission (CCRC) confirms that the judicial decision
referenced in the article was formally issued on 24
December 2022. The article appears to rely on earlier
material that predates the actual decision and presents
preliminary information as if it were final.

2. Removal of the Original Source

On 23 December 2025, ESCC removed its original
Newsroom article. Your platform continues to host
content that relies on material no longer available from
the original source.

3. No Official Notification

I have never received any formal notification or
certified copy of the judgment referenced in the article.
The information reported cannot be verified against
any document officially served to me.

4. Ongoing Dissemination

Despite the removal of the original ESCC publication, the content continues to circulate through cached versions, search-engine snippets, third-party aggregators, and republications. The version on your platform contributes to this ongoing dissemination of outdated information.

Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter is sent pursuant to the Pre-Action Protocol for Media and Communications Claims under the Civil Procedure Rules of

England and Wales.

1. Publication Identified

The following publication disseminated by PressReader is the subject of this notice:

The publication contains inaccurate statements and unlawfully processed personal data. It also reproduces or relies upon material originally issued by East Sussex County Council (ESCC), which has since been removed due to its unlawful nature.

2. Background and Procedural Irregularities

On 23 December 2025, ESCC removed its original Newsroom article following a formal complaint lodged in Italy. This removal confirms that the information lacked any lawful basis for publication.

Documentation from the Criminal Cases Review Commission (CCRC) establishes that the judgment was legally issued on 24 December 2022. Despite this, the PressReader-hosted article dated 2 January 2023 reproduces content originating from earlier unlawful publications. Those earlier publications pre-dated the existence of any judgment and relied on a non-existent judicial act.

ESCC has further confirmed in writing that it relied solely on a prosecution summary, not a judgment. A prosecution summary is unilateral, unverified, and cannot lawfully support a public communication presented as a concluded judicial fact.

3. Absence of Service of the Judgment

The judgment has never been formally served to me. No notification, certified copy, or proof of service exists in any

jurisdiction. Without service, the judgment cannot acquire procedural finality and cannot be lawfully reported, processed, or disseminated. Any publication referring to it is therefore unlawful ab initio.

4. Incomplete Removal and Ongoing Dissemination

ESCC removed only the article, leaving snippets, cached versions, indexed previews, metadata, search-engine traces, and third-party reproductions. The removal was therefore incomplete, and the unlawful publication continues to persist across platforms. As the publication originated before any judgment existed, the illegality is established ab origine and remains ongoing.

5. Previous Pre-Action Protocol and Criminal Proceedings

ESCC removed the article only on 23 December 2022, despite a previous Pre-Action Protocol deadline of 4 December 2022. A formal criminal complaint (“querela”) was filed before the Tribunale Penale di Pavia on 23 December 2022. The administrative phase has now concluded, and criminal investigations are commencing against all entities involved in the dissemination.

6. Legal Grounds

Your continued publication engages liability under:

- Defamation (libel)
- UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018
- Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974
- Relevant case law, including Google Spain (C-131/12)

The conviction became spent on 23 December 2024. Any continued dissemination constitutes an ongoing violation of the Rehabilitation of Offenders

Act 1974.

7. Impact

The publication continues to cause reputational harm, dissemination of inaccurate and spent-conviction data, indexing and re-indexing by search engines, and persistent accessibility through third-party platforms.

The platform is structured as a progressive web application (PWA) with continuous monitoring, automated indexing, and controlled replication across multiple channels, ensuring full traceability of all developments, including persistent third-party dissemination.

9. Forthcoming Schedules: Issues, Harm, and Compensation

Three structured documents are being finalised and will be provided separately:

- Schedule of Issues
- Schedule of Harm
- Schedule of Compensation

All schedules will be calculated ab initio, as the unlawful publication originated on 22 December 2022, two days before the hearing and before any judgment existed in legal terms.

10. Required Actions

You are requested to:

- remove the publication and all associated content, including cached versions, previews, metadata, tags, categories, archives, and indexing elements;
- erase all personal data relating to me

processed in connection with the publication;

- confirm in writing the actions taken within 14 days of receipt of this notice;
- provide information regarding the source of the material, the editorial process followed, and any third-party dissemination.

If you fail to provide a substantive response within 14 days, I reserve the right to initiate further action without further notice, including but not limited to issuing proceedings in the appropriate jurisdiction.

11. Restriction on Direct Contact
Due to ongoing criminal proceedings in Italy and the extraterritorial applicability of the GDPR under Article 3, you must not contact me directly. All communication must be made exclusively through the formal channels specified in this notice.
