Your position is not compatible with the GDPR. The information at issue is personal data, and its accuracy and continued dissemination fall under your independent obligations as a data controller. Internal licensing arrangements or publisher-approval workflows do not override Articles 5, 16 and 17 GDPR. The primary source has been removed, all archival mirrors have been taken down, the data is contested, and a criminal proceeding concerning the underlying facts is currently pending in Italy. Continued distribution under these conditions is not compatible with the GDPR's accuracy and necessity requirements. You are therefore required to reassess the processing and take appropriate action.

Your reply is now deemed a refusal to act on a fully documented request and has therefore compelled me to escalate my legal actions.

Dear Editor,

This communication is to formally notify your organisation of a significant procedural development concerning the former Yahoo UK article relating to the *Riccardo Gresta – Eastbourne Blue Badge* matter.

On **10 February 2026**, the **Internet Archive** registered the case under a dedicated internal ticket and initiated the exclusion of all archived snapshots of the withdrawn Yahoo UK article previously available at:

Yahoo UK had already removed the publication. The Wayback Machine has now taken action to remove historical mirrors, confirming that the material is no longer treated as “current news” and that its continued availability would have perpetuated inaccurate and harmful processing. This intervention demonstrates that global archival infrastructures respond when presented with documented procedural irregularities.

It is also relevant to note that the Internet Archive completed its review and exclusion process **within 48 hours** of receiving, on **8 February 2026**, formal notice of the criminal complaint filed in December 2025 in Italy (*denuncia-querela*). This timing forms part of the broader procedural context of the case.

Given that several UK outlets reproduced the original ESCC material, this notification is provided for transparency and accuracy. The following organisations republished or amplified the ESCC narrative:
