You will need a computer or device with Microsoft Teams downloaded onto it to attend a virtual ceremony with East Sussex.

- To download MS Teams go to <https://teams.microsoft.com/uswe-01/downloads>. Please test your access to the MS Teams App before the day of your ceremony to avoid unnecessary delays.

At least 3 days before the ceremony we will email you an invitation to attend and a link to join us for your ceremony on MS Teams. Please ensure you join on time. If you are late, we may have to delay your ceremony.

When you join us for your virtual ceremony, you must be able to show the registrar:

- Your invitation letter issued from the Home Office
- A valid form of photographic ID (e.g. passport, travel document, driving licence or biometric residence card)

Your ceremony cannot proceed without both of the above documents

Your citizenship ceremony will take approximately 15 minutes.

- Your naturalization certificate will be sent to the address on your Home Office invitation letter by secure delivery within 3-5 working days. You will need to sign for delivery.
- It is not possible for your certificate to be sent to a different address.
- If you have moved house, you need to inform the Home Office of your new address. Your certificate will not be sent until the new address is confirmed to us by the Home Office.
- It is not possible to collect your certificate from the register office.

You must let us know if you cannot attend the ceremony.
